The Church requires, all previous marriages by both spouses to be determined Null. An annulment is an investigation to determine the validity of the marriage. Marriage is sacred and permanent; unless the marriage was unlawful (Matthew 19).

Dear potential Godparent,

Being selected to be a Godparent is a special honor. With this honor comes certain responsibilities. Below are the requirements of the Catholic Church. These requirements must be met. If you are unable to meet these requirements you cannot serve as a Godparent.

REQUIREMENTS:

☐ Canon 873 – There may be only one male godparent or one female godparent or one of each.

☐ Canon 874 - To be permitted to take on the function of godparent a person must:

1. Be at least 16 years of age;
2. Received the three sacraments of initiation: Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation and be living a life of faith in keeping with the Faith.
4. Not bound by any canonical penalty legitimately imposed or declared by the Church
5. Must not be the father or mother of the one who is being baptized;
6. **If married, MUST be married within the Catholic Church.**

§2 A baptized person who belongs to a non-Catholic Christian community may not be a Godparent but can serve as a Christian Witness along side a Godparent.

Before completing this form, please prayerful consider if you are willing to take on this responsibility, which includes your commitment to serve as a model of faith for this child, not just at the time of baptism but in the years ahead.
