The Catholic Church holds marriage to be sacred and permanent; according to Jesus' own words in Matthew 19-a marriage has to be lawful.

A Declaration of Nullity normally takes 1 year to complete, so if you need a Declaration of Nullity, it is most likely that you would have to wait until next year's class to be eligible to come into the Catholic Church.
